

Department of Psychiatry – Graduate Student Publication Awards

Description:

To be awarded annually to graduate students in the Department of Psychiatry for the best peer-reviewed publication. Two awards are offered, normally one in each of the following areas: Biomedical Research; Clinical and Population Health Research. Priority will be given to original research papers over review papers. Recipients will be chosen by evaluation and ranking through the Graduate Program Committee. The Graduate Program Committee reserves the right to withhold the award(s) in any given year.

Conditions: The applicant has been enrolled part- or full-time as a graduate student in the Department of Psychiatry during the current calendar year. The publication has to be first-authored by the student and in press or in print by the end of the calendar year. No publication can be submitted more than once in subsequent calendar years.

Application materials:

- 1) Electronic copy of the publication in press or in print in the calendar year preceding the application deadline (i.e., the application deadline March 1, 2012 includes publications in press or printed between Jan 01, 2011 – Dec 31, 2011).
- 2) For publications in press, confirmation by the publisher needs to be enclosed.
- 3) A short description outlining the significance of your publication and why it should receive the award (150 words maximum).
